AN ACT

1 Declaring portions of State Route 32 (Legislative Route 326),  
2 State Route 611 (Legislative Route 168), State Route 209  
3 (Legislative Route 1103), and Legislative Routes 48025 and  
4 48073 that follow adjacent to the Delaware River as the  
5 Delaware River Scenic Drive.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Declaration.

9 (a) Specified routes.--Because of the outstanding natural,  
10 historical and cultural qualities of those interconnecting  
11 routes adjacent to the Delaware River, the following routes are  
12 declared beautiful and scenic:

13 (1) That portion of State Route 32 (Legislative Route  
14 326), commencing from its intersection with U.S. Route 1,  
15 north to its terminus at State Route 611 (Legislative Route  
16 168).

17 (2) That portion of State Route 611 (Legislative Route  
18 168), from the terminus of State Route 32 (Legislative Route  
19 326), north to its juncture with State Route 209 (Legislative

1 Route 1103).

2 (3) That portion of Legislative Route 48025, from its  
3 juncture with State Route 611 (Legislative Route 168), east  
4 to its terminus at Legislative Route 48073.

5 (4) Legislative Route 48073, from its beginning to  
6 Legislative Route 48025, north to its terminus at State Route  
7 611 (Legislative Route 168).

8 (5) That portion of State Route 209 (Legislative Route  
9 1103), from its juncture with State Route 611 (Legislative  
10 Route 168), north and ending at its juncture with U.S.  
11 Interstate Route 84.

12 (b) Name.--The above routes are designated the Delaware  
13 River Scenic Drive.

14 Section 2. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect immediately.
