## **EPA Reviews Cleanup at the Revere Chemical Company Site**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a third Five-Year Review of the **Revere Chemical Company Superfund site** located in Nockamixon Township, Bucks County. This review seeks to confirm that all components of the long-term cleanup work completed in 1998, which comprised removal of contamination; installation of a multi-layer cap, and construction of a storm water management system, continue to be protective of human health and the environment. EPA last reviewed the site in 2006 found that the remedy was protective of public health and the environment. In addition, the 2006 review recommended that the institutional controls restricting activity, use and access be modified to ensure the EPA and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection are provided opportunity to comment on any proposed reuse of the site. Since then, institutional controls have been modified to reflect this recommendation regarding future reuse of the site.

### **What is an EPA Five-Year Review?**

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

### **When will this site's Five-Year Review Report be available?**

The Five-Year Review report will be finalized and made available in the administrative record repository for the site (see below), as well as online at <http://epa.gov/5yr> in May 2011.
